




#### **Workshop on Model United Nations**

#### Three Week Induction Program for the Students


Induction program for students of B.E. I year at Matrusri Engineering College was conducted from 21<sup>st</sup> July 2018.





## Report on the student attributes facilitated by the Institute



## REPORT ON THE STUDENT ATTRIBUTES FACILITATED BY THE INSTITUTION

Matrusri Engineering College has worked to develop desirable attitudes in students through a code of conduct that helps them in personal and professional lives. The students trained to value their worth and create a positive and productive atmosphere guided by a sense of responsibility in endorsing the institute's quality across various states and nations in which they work. The student counseling process is carried out effectively to bind teachers and students in a relationship of cordiality and mutual trust which continues even after they pass out of the programs in this institute. The departments help in gathering student feedback which in turn help in qualitative improvement of both the teaching process and infrastructural facilities. Harmonious relations exist among the students because of a check on deviant behaviors through grievance redressal cell, anti-ragging committee, anti-sexual harassment and women protection cell and department associations that keep students focused on discipline and developing competencies, thereby reducing the scope for distractions. Maximum attendance is ensured through personal counseling and by intimating parents about student attendance through letters. Acceptance of diversity and uniqueness is taught through team work and gender equity programs. Patriotism is cultivated through celebration of national festivals. Unity, discipline, selflessness, social responsibility and concern for fellow beings are taught through the institute.
